### Directions:

**Please initial each step as you complete it. This sheet will be turned in with your final piece.**

\_\_\_\_ You will be divided up into your small groups to sit and discuss several themes that are found in Hatchet. You should be taking notes and listing specific evidence from the novel to prove, or support, your theme statements. Take good notes because after this step, you are on your own. Keep your notes. You will turn them in with your writing.

\_\_\_\_ Now that your notes are complete, it is time to draft. You are no longer working in a group, rather you are now on your own for the rest of this assignment. Head your paper Rough Draft #1. This will be collected with your final piece. Make sure you skip a space after every line. The purpose of this writing is to reveal themes found in the novel.

\_\_\_\_ Look at your finished draft and compare it to the rubric for the assignment. Have you met all of the requirements of content, organization, voice, sentence fluency, word choice, editing, mechanics, and most importantly, have you followed directions? Make all editing marks and/or notes on your draft. Have another student read over your draft making editing marks and/or comments. Read their marks and/or notes. Some of you may want an adult's opinion. This is a good idea. Take it home for further editing, but be sure to bring it back to school with you the next day.

\_\_\_\_ Head a new sheet of paper Rough Draft #2. This will also be collected with your final piece. Again, make sure you skip a space after every line. Rewrite your rough draft using any editing marks and notes you want to make changes. Again, compare your draft to the rubric. If you have met all the requirements, then you are ready for the next step.

\_\_\_\_ Head a piece of composition paper as follows:

\_\_\_\_ Begin writing your final copy using proper paragraph form. Do **NOT** skip spaces between lines or paragraphs. You may type your final paper. If you choose to type your paper you must be sure to have the same heading listed above, 12pt. times new roman font only, double spaced, and one-inch margins all around. Once your final copy is complete you may move on to the last step.
